Alumni Success Story – Jacob Denmark

The next time you receive an Amazon delivery, think about OWTS and Jacob Denmark. Jacob was a 2019 Electronics graduate. Directly out of technical school, Jacob got a job as a service technician for JLL Services. JLL is a contractor supporting Amazon Automation. Keeping automated conveyors, picking, and packaging equipment running is his top priority. If a system goes down, packages back up fast. Jacob is responsible for keeping the Amazon Fulfillment Center in Windsor running.

In his years at Oliver Wolcott, Jacob was involved with Work Based Learning, gaining valuable electronic experience at Wittmann Battenfeld. Wittmann is a key supporter of our Work Based Learning program. At OWTS Jacob was involved with student government and a SkillsUSA officer. Per Instructor Mr. Royal Allard, he was a stellar student.

SkillsUSA is a partnership of students, teachers and industry working together to ensure America has a skilled workforce for the future. Their nationally recognized program promotes competition preparing students for careers in trade, technical and skilled service occupations. Jacob was a top contestant in state competition. He went on to the national convention in Louisville. Jacob remembers SkillsUSA as a rewarding experience "building technical, team building and leadership skills that directly apply to his career at Amazon". In Jacob's senior year he was selected as Chapter President, a valuable introduction to his leadership responsibilities at Amazon.

He credits OWTS, and Mr. Allard's class, as a hands-on learning environment. Similar to industry, you design and build something. The first time, systems never work. You trouble-shoot, revise, rebuild and test until you get it right. Jacob is a shining example of a motivated student, applying himself and succeeding in a promising career directly after graduation. He is presently working on a college degree with financial assistance from his employer.



A New Location for OWTS — Let's Make Some Noise

We first wrote about a new facility for Oliver Wolcott in our 2014 newsletter. It's been 8 years. Plans seemed to have stalled. Our latest update is "we're looking for a location". This is a call to Alumni for action. If suitable land is not available in Torrington, do we need to expand our search to a neighboring community? There is property by Torrington Middle School, property across from Home Depot, and hundreds of acres outside of Torrington. We are asking for your help to find a solution!

In the last 10 years the State constructed 17 New CREC Schools of Excellence. We've seen expansions of Community Colleges and other Technical High Schools. Oliver Wolcott, in the Northwest Corner, has been forgotten.

We ask that you call your representative to get this ball rolling. Alumni and business owners can make a difference. This is an appeal to business owners. Representatives listen to Employers!


